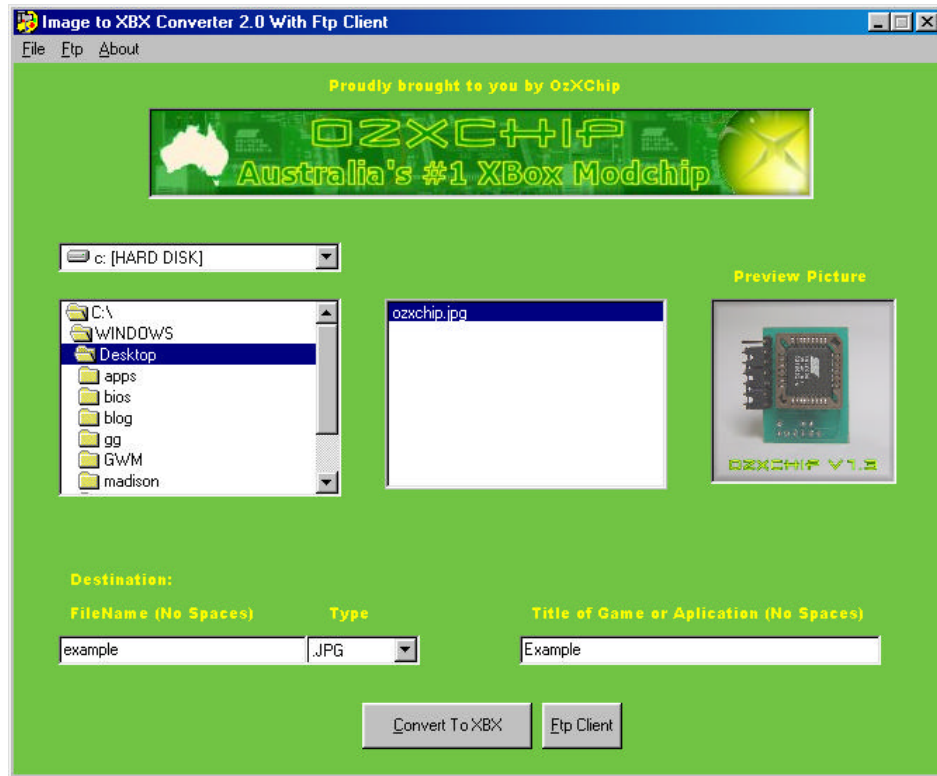


Image To XBX Converter 2.0

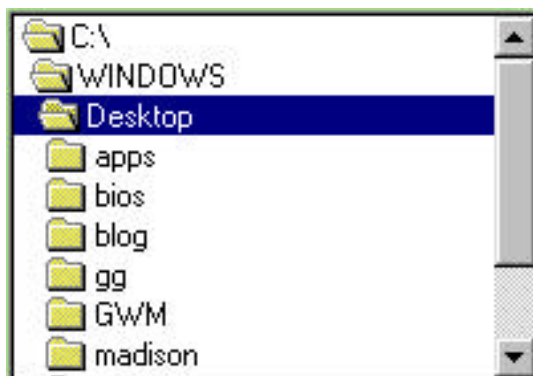

When you start Image to XBX Converter 2.0 you are presented with the screen shown above.



In this drop down menu you simply select the drive that contains the graphic file you wish to convert to an XBX file.



This directory selection menu is used to locate the folder in which the file you wish to convert to XBX is located in.



Select the file in which you want to convert to the XBX file format.

Destination:

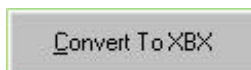
FileName (No Spaces)	Type
example	.JPG

In the FileName field type the name of the converted file you want saved to your harddisk (ensure you do not use spaces). You then select the PC file format you wish to use from JPG, GIF or BMP.

Title of Game or Application (No Spaces)

Example

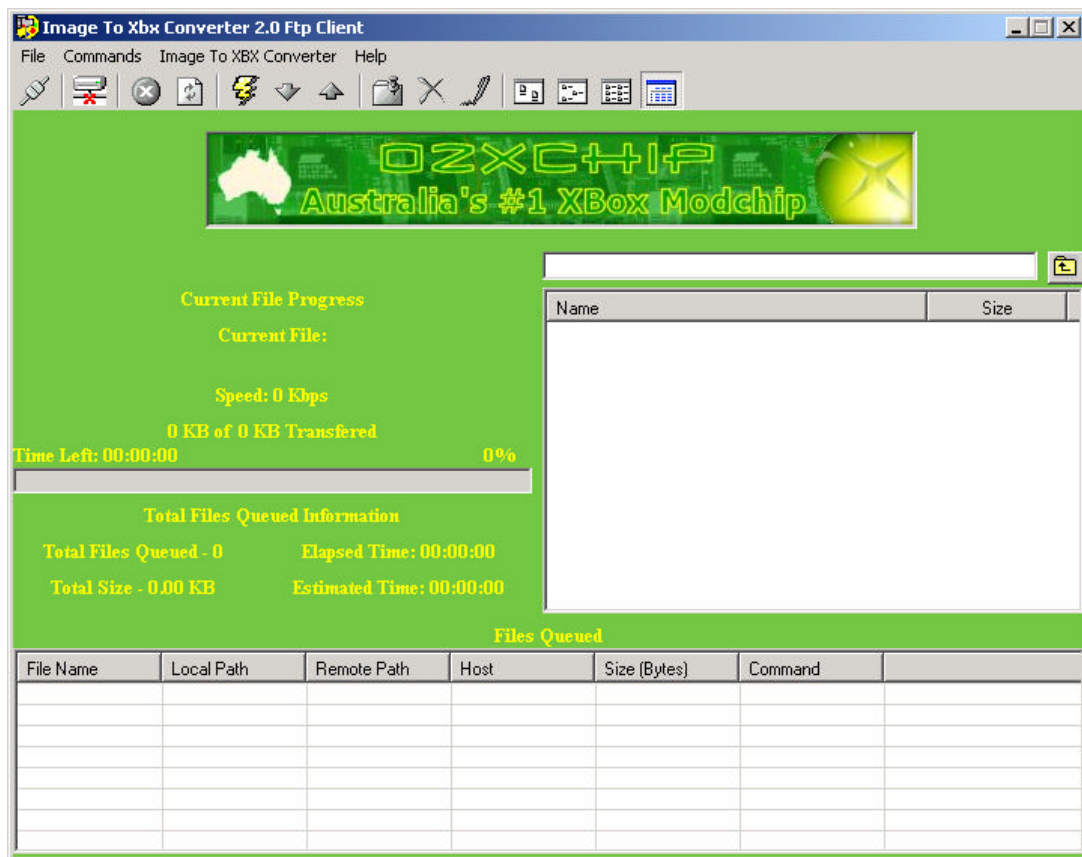
Enter the title of the Game or Application and ensure spaces are not used in this field.



To create the XBX file click on the Convert To XBX icon.



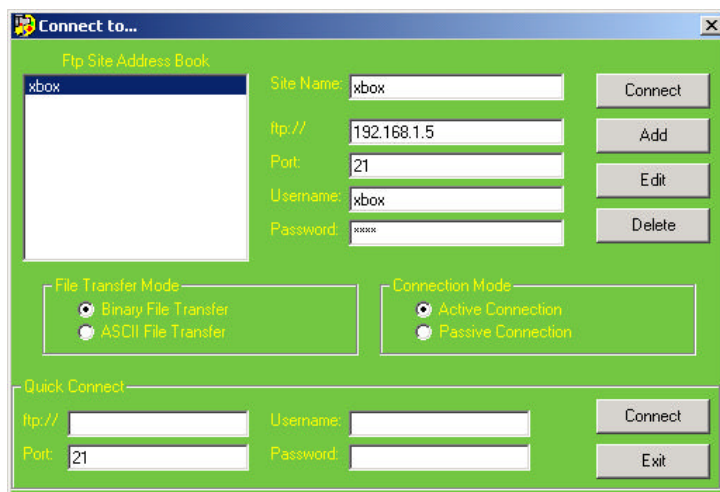
To upload the XBX file to your Xbox click on the Ftp Client.



The screen shown above is the FTP Client that is built into Image To XBOX Converter that allows you to upload your XBOX files directly to your console without the need for any other software.



Firstly click on the Connect icon to connect to your XBox.



You can modify the default “xbox” entry with the correct IP address and username/password settings to suit your XBox’s network configuration or you can create a new entries to suit your requirements.

When complete click on the Connect icon.

In the FTP Client's directory selection box locate the folder within e:\UDATA that you wish to upload your new XBX file to.



Now select the Add files to queue for upload and locate the XBX file to upload. Our example XBX file was called
C:\Program Files\Image to XBX Converter 2.0\Example\TitleImage.XBX

File Name	Local Path	Remote Path	Host	Size (Bytes)	Command
TitleImage.xbx	C:\Program Files\Image To Xbx Converter 2.0\XBX\Example...	/E:/UDATA/ffff...	192.168.1.5	10240	Upload

Your screen should look similar to that shown above, now to transfer the XBX file simply click on the Transfer Queue icon on the toolbar.
